At the Atelier Montfollet SAS, Anne Brugirard, a graduate of the École Nationale Supérieure des Arts Appliqués et des Métiers d'Art in Paris and Master-Artisan in Métiers d'Art, works on stained glass window creation or restoration projects on order from public or private commissions, both religious and secular, as well as on heritage listed Monuments Historiques such as the Cathedral of Annecy (Haute Savoie), Tour Bayard (St Maximin, Isère), Barraux Fort (Isère) The Casamaures (St Martin-le-Vinoux, Isère).

Alongside the traditional business of restoration, Anne Brugirard dedicates herself to artistic research, with the creation of original works, examples of which can be seen in Franche-Comté, Rhône-Alpes, Savoie, the Loire (Rivas) and around Grenoble (St Ondras, Roybon (Abbey Chambarand), Sassenage (Notre-Dame des Vignes), Revel-Tourdan (St Jean-Baptiste), etc.

The Workshop opens to the public on European Heritage Days and Artistic Craft Days, offering talks and workshop tours for groups. Atelier Montfollet understands that explaining the complexities of its business contributes significantly to its preservation.
